Purple Wind is a 5W Class AB Guitar Amplifier Head

Features

Panel Instructions



Front

- 1.INPUT: 1/4" mono jack, plug in your guitar.
- 2.BASS: Control the low frequency response.
- 3.MIDDLE: Control the mid frequency response.
- 4.TREBLE: Control the high frequency response.
- 5.GAIN: Control the gain level.
- 6.VOLUME: Control the output volume.

Back

- 18V DC:
 - Plug in 18V DC adapter (center negative).
- 2 PHONES/LINE OUTPUT: 1/8" stereo jack, for using headphones or recording.
- **3** AUX IN: 1/8" stereo jack, for connecting an external music player.
- FX LOOP SEND:

 1/4"mono jack, send the signal to the Input jack of the connected effect unit (The Effects Loop is a patch point between the pre-amp and power amp).
- FX LOOP RETURN:
 - 1/4"mono jack, connect to the Output jack of the connected effect unit.
- **6** SPEAKER OUTPUT: 1/4" mono jack, for connecting to the cabinet (speaker 4-16 Ω).
